The Connecticut Greenhouse Growers Association announces an annual scholarship program. The purpose to the program is to provide support to those interested in pursuing careers in greenhouse crop production or related areas of ornamental horticulture by providing awards of \$500 for the purchase of textbooks or related electronic educational materials.

Eligibility: There are two eligibility categories: (1) individual students who are formally enrolled in post-high school educational programs in greenhouse/ornamental horticulture; and (2) High school program leaders or instructors in greenhouse/ornamental horticulture. Awards are for Connecticut residents or Connecticut based programs only.

Timetable: Applications must be received by July 1. Awardees will be selected in July and checks will be mailed prior to the start of the fall semester.
